#### **GETTING STARTED**


Sign up on the JERA website to indicate your interest in going solar. You will provide your contact information, energy consumption (found on your electricity bill), and ownership preference.

## SCOPING, ASSESSMENT, AND DESIGN

You will be matched with a JERA partner who will conduct a site visit, review your business' energy needs, and provide options for suitable PV or PV plus battery storage (PV+) projects. After discussing anticipated savings and receiving your approval, your JERA partner will design the proposed PV/PV+ system.

#### FINANCING

JERA partners will go over your system design and PV/PV+ financing options with you. Specific terms and requirements will depend on the financing type, including direct financing or leasing.



## CONTRACT SIGNING

Once you agree on the benefits of your PV/PV+ system, you will sign an agreement with JERA partners for installation and financing. Your JERA partner will support you throughout the installation process.

# PERMITTING, LICENSING, AND INSTALLATION

Your JERA partner will obtain permits in accordance with local regulations and expert technicians will work to install your PV/PV+ system.





## SITE INSPECTION AND INTERCONNECTION

Your JERA partner will coordinate an inspection with the utility. Upon passing inspection and receiving interconnection approval (if applicable), your PV/PV+ system can begin generating power and saving you money.
